"I'm turning green! Watch out, I'm turning green!" In the locker room before a game you can sometimes hear Douglas, a three-time Pro Bowl, chanting that phrase. Just as Dr. Bruce Banner transforms from an every day man into the most powerful man-like creature ever to walk the earth, the Incredible Hulk, Douglas transforms into something equally exciting and powerful on gameday. Douglas does seem to have a different personality when game time arrives. On any other day he's the one cracking jokes or providing the media with a great sound bite, but it's all business when he gets to the stadium. A former first round draft choice of the NY Jets and the 1995 NFL defensive rookie of the year, Douglas was re-signed by the Eagles on 9/1/04 for a second stint with the squad. He was originally acquired by

Philadelphia in a trade with the Jets on 3/13/98 in exchange for the Eagles 2nd and 5th round draft choices that year. In his previous five seasons in the midnight green, he collected 51.5 sacks in 66 games ranking him 3rd on the Eagles all-time list behind only Reggie White (124) and Clyde Simmons (76.5).

**BIRDSEED:**

- A renowned chatterbox on game day, was banned from riding the same bus as head coach Andy Reid. Said Reid, "He likes to talk and sing, and I don't. But the one time I told him to stop, he played the worst game. So I turned him loose ... Hugh's a wonderful, funny guy who'll talk to anyone for as long as they want. He'll get on people, sure, but he's not overbearing or mean-spirited. He doesn't call people out. He doesn't overdo it."
- An avid collector and reader of comic books, his favorites characters are Wolverine, The Incredible Hulk, and The Punisher. He got hooked on comics as a child while reading the West Coast Avengers comic book at the laundromat with his father

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Started 16 games for Jacksonville in 2003 after signing with the Jaguars as a free agent on 3/17/03. Led the team with 3 FFs and was 2nd with 36 hurries
- In his 100th career start at NYJ (11/23/03), the team that drafted him in 1995, posted 1 sack (QB Chad Pennington), 1 TFL and 2 hurries
- Posted 1.5 sacks of QB Steve McNair, 1 FF and 2 hurries at Ten. (11/16/03)
- Made a third-straight trip to Hawaii as a member of the NFC Pro Bowl squad in 2002. Also a first-team All Pro selection by *Football Digest*, a second-team selection by AP and an All NFC pick by *Pro Football Weekly*
- Tied for 4th in the NFL in sacks (12.5) and led the team in both hurries (25) and TFLs (9) as an Eagle in 2002. Posted at least a half-sack in 11 of 16 regular season games
- Notched 2 4th-qr. sacks at Chi. (11/3/02) for the 17th multiple-sack game of his career. The 2nd sack stalled a Bears comeback on their final drive
- Earned his second consecutive trip to the Pro Bowl as a starter in 2001, as he led the Eagles for the 2nd straight year with 9.5 sacks. Garnered All-NFL honors from *Football Digest* and *College and Pro Football News Weekly*. His efforts earned him a selection to the All-Madden Team and a 2nd consecutive selection to Howie Long's "Tough Guy" Team
- Registered 2 sacks in the 2001 playoffs. His second came against Bears QB Shane Matthews in the NFC Divisional Playoff Game (1/19). Earlier in that contest, Douglas' block on Bears QB Jim Miller on an INT return knocked the QB out of the game and helped set the tone for the Eagles win
- With 39 sacks as an Eagle (61.0 career), ranks 5th in club history behind Reggie White (124.0), Clyde Simmons (76.5), Greg Brown (50.5), and Andy Harmon (40.0)
- Has 16 multiple sack games, including 3 of 3-or-more sacks. Tallied 4.5 sacks in a two-week span in 2001. Had 2 sacks at Arz. (11/4/01) of QB Jake Plummer and then posted 2.5 vs. Min. (11/11) of QB Daunte Culpepper
- In 2000, earned his first trip to the Pro Bowl as a starting DE after ranking 4th in the NFL with a career-high 15 sacks. In addition to being named first-team All-NFL by Associated Press, *Pro Football Weekly* and *Sports Illustrated*, he was also voted by his teammates as the Eagles defensive MVP

- Earned NFC defensive player of the month honors in September, 2000 for his league-leading 6.5 sacks, 10 QB pressures, and 21 tackles, including 4 for a loss
- Recorded his first pro INT off of Chris Chandler vs. Atl. (10/1/00)
- Named NFL Defensive Player of the Week after recording an Eagles postseason record 2 sacks of QB Shaun King in the Wild Card game vs. TB (12/31). The first sack forced a fumble by King and was converted into the Eagles first TD
- Led the Eagles in 1998 and ranked 7th in the NFL with a 12.5 sacks en route to earning All-Madden Team honors in his first season in Phila.
- Was named NFC Defensive Player of the Month for October, 1998 as he registered 7 sacks among his 20 tackles in just 3 games, including a career-high 4.5 sacks of Ryan Leaf at SD (10/18/98) to tie a club record set by Clyde Simmons on 9/15/91 at Dal.
- In 1996, his final season with the Jets, led the team for the second straight year with 8 sacks
- Recorded his only touchdown at any level of play when he returned a fumble (Stanley Pritchett) 62 yards for a score vs. Mia. (12/22/96)
- Became the consensus NFL defensive rookie of the year in 1995 after recording 10 sacks, 2.5 shy of the NFL rookie record held by Leslie O'Neal. Broke the Jets rookie record of 8 set by Joe Klecko in 1977

- In 2001, was awarded the Jack Edelstein Memorial Award for the 2nd straight season. The award is presented to the Eagle player with an uplifting manner, a love for life, and an exceptional sense of humor who makes all with whom he comes in contact with, feel good. The award is voted on by the Philadelphia media
- With the Jets, Douglas learned hand-fighting techniques from former Dallas Cowboy Randy White's instructional video



• In 1999, started the Hugh Douglas Foundation (HDF), which benefits children in the Mansfield area. In addition, Hugh donated \$50,000 to the Eagles Book Mobile, which has visited more than 250 sites and has given away more than 62,000 free books to children in the Philadelphia area who have never owned a book

• Following the '96 football season, Central State dropped its football program; however, Douglas already has discussed with school officials how he could help them field a team in the future

**COLLEGE:**

A two-time NAIA Division I All-American, Douglas would line up against Erik Williams, the Cowboys former all-pro tackle, in practice each day. As a senior, was named defensive player of the year by the Washington D.C. Pigskin Club and had four sacks in the Hula Bowl. Helped lead the Marauders to the national championship as a sophomore.

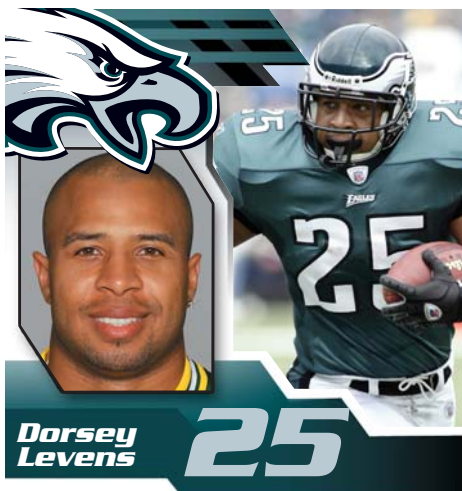

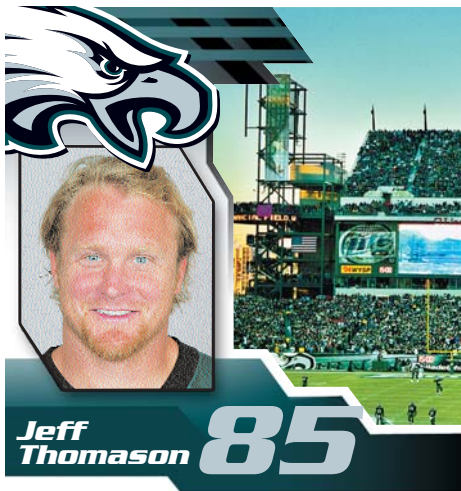
